

# 40 Days for Life Prayer Vigil at Planned Parenthood

Planned Parenthood opened a new abortion clinic in Waukegan IL last spring. Area parishes have quickly mobilized and a 40 Days for Life campaign will occur in front of Planned Parenthood from September 23 through November 1. Peaceful, prayerful public witness will happen there from 8am to 8pm every day of the campaign. Please come out and pray for an end to the brutal murder of preborn children outside the Planned Parenthood building at 1601 N Lewis Ave, Waukegan, IL - take Sheridan Road south, right/west on York Road, left/south on CtyW134 (Lewis Ave).
