Miraculous Prayer to the Little Flower

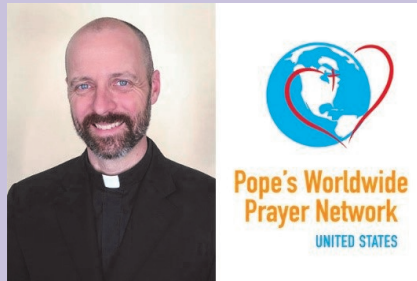
