### **Miraculous Prayer to the Little Flower**

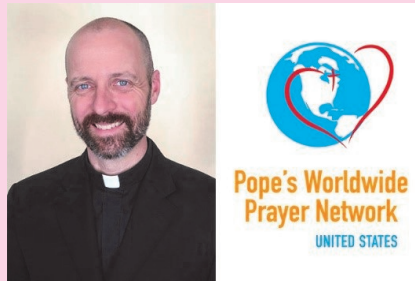
