
OUR PARISH MISSION

Dr. Conrad Baars, a famous Catholic psychiatrist who had been sent to a concentration camp during World War II, once expressed the true paradigm shift which the approval of contraception causes: "[B]irth control appeals so much to the selfish element in every human being. Pro-Life States Will File Lawsuit against Biden's Illegal Plan to Turn VA Hospitals into Abortion Clinics

(Steve Ertelt, *LifeSiteNews*, Sept. 16, 2022) Pro-Life states are gearing up for a lawsuit against the Biden administration after Joe Biden finalized a plan to turn VA hospitals into abortion clinics. States like Alabama and Arkansas will likely be leading the way in defending their abortion bans from the federal government usurping them by authorizing VA hospitals to sell dangerous abortion drugs or do surgical abortions ending the lives of unborn children. Biden's move is already a violation of federal law that prohibits the taxpayer-funded VA medical centers from doing abortions but it also violates the *Dobbs* decision, whereby the Supreme Court gave states the ability to protect babies from abortions.

Leading pro-life group Susan B. Anthony Pro-Life slammed the decision and reiterated that it is illegal, in violation of both federal and state laws. "This is the latest egregious example of the pro-abortion extremism that has taken over the Democratic Party. Biden himself used to agree taxpayers should never be forced to fund the destruction of innocent life. Now he is head of the most pro-abortion administration in history. There is no law they won't rewrite or institution they won't destroy in their drive to impose abortion without limits – even late-term abortions well after unborn children can feel pain – up to the moment of birth, paid for by taxpayers, nationwide."
