OUR PARISH MISSION

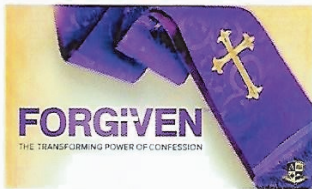

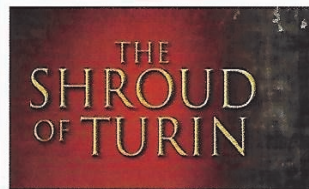
HIGHLIGHTS ON FORMED



Forgiven: The Transforming Power of Confession

As we prepare to celebrate Easter, encourage your parishioners to experience

the grace and healing of confession this Lent. One great way to direct them toward the Sacrament of Reconciliation is through *Forgiven*. This series is a beautiful introduction or reminder of how God invites each one of us to encounter his deep and merciful love. By examining Scripture and walking through the rite of Confession, *Forgiven* shows how God’s mercy is unending and inexhaustible.



The Shroud of Turin

Have you ever wondered about the shroud that captures the face of Christ? This collection of four films

uncovers the truth behind the Shroud of Turin while using the latest scientific, historical, medical, and archaeological research. As we remember Christ’s Passion and death this Lent, enrich your parishioners’ knowledge of this remarkable and holy artifact through each part of this series. Hear from leading experts in this outstanding presentation of the burial cloth of Christ.

The Lenten season is a valuable time to renew the heart of your parish. Each person can deepen their relationship with the Lord through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. As the Church “repent[s] and believe[s] in the gospel” (Mk 1:15), aid your parishioners’ Lenten journey with these resources from FORMED.



Restore: Lent with Sr. Miriam James Heidland

Viewers will encounter the heart of Jesus Christ as they walk with Sr.

Miriam James Heidland, SOLT, this Lent. These Lenten reflections focus on the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, situating them within the context of how they can help heal one’s relationship with God and others. Each week, Sr. Miriam guides participants in a reflection centered on allowing the Lord to come into their hearts’ deepest and potentially darkest places. This series offers impactful Lenten reflections and aims to restore each person to wholeness.

How can someone prepare in the season of Lent? As each person mirrors the actions of Christ in the desert, they can use this time of Lent as preparation for joining themselves with Christ on the cross. This Lent, show others they can let the Holy Spirit lead them into the spiritual desert as they grow closer and closer to the Lord.



Lent with Brother Francis

Lent with Brother Francis is an excellent tool to guide children as they begin to learn about the season

of Lent. In each episode, Brother Francis provides a short meditation with which the entire family can follow. The end of every video also offers a discussion prompt so parents can have deeper conversations with their kids about the meaning of Lent.
