Fr. Edward Looney is a priest for the Diocese of Green Bay, Wisconsin, and currently serves as Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish, Shawano. A member and past President of the Mariological Society of America, Fr. Looney has authored many books and has published in theological journals on topics related to Mariology.

Fr. Looney has expertise regarding the apparitions by Our Lady of Champion (formerly called Our Lady of Good Help) to Adele Brice. Texts on this topic: *Our Lady of Good Help: Mary's Name, Message and Mission* and *The Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help: Frequently Asked Questions*.  ***Ash Wednesday** is a day of both **abstinence & fasting**: Everyone 14 years old and up must abstain from meat; 18 to 65 years old must also fast: have only one full meal, may eat 2 other meals that together do not equal the main meal, and no eating between meals.
 ***Abstinence** from meat is required on **ALL FRIDAYS** during Lent; and **GOOD FRIDAY** is also a day of both **abstinence and fasting**.
