Fr. Edward Looney is a priest for the Diocese of Green Bay, Wisconsin, and currently serves as Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish, Shawano. A member and past President of the Mariological Society of America, Fr. Looney has authored many books and has published in theological journals on topics related to Mariology.

Fr. Looney has expertise regarding the apparitions by Our Lady of Champion (formerly called Our Lady of Good Help) to Adele Brice. Texts on this topic: *Our Lady of Good Help: Mary's Name, Message and Mission* and *The Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help: Frequently Asked Questions*. He has authored a number of devotional works: *Praying the Rosary with Sister Adele*, *A Novena to the Queen of Heaven Our Lady of Good Help*, *A Rosary Litany*, and *A Heart Like Mary's: 31 Daily Meditations to Help You Live and Love as She Does*; and two children's books: *The Story of Sister Adele*, and *Breakfast in Bethlehem*.
